1. Students from another department who choose the Department of Economics (hereinafter, the Department) as a minor should have a GPA of 2.92 or above in every semester in the previous academic year. The Admissions Committee of the Department will admit students based on the merits.

2. Students who choose the Department as a minor are required to pass the following courses, with a total of 28 credits:
 - (1) Principles of Microeconomics with Recitation and Principles of Macroeconomics with Recitation (4, 4);
 - (2) Microeconomics (I) & (II) (3, 3), Macroeconomics (I) & (II) (3, 3);
 - (3) Statistics with Recitation and Introductory Econometrics with Recitation (4, 4).

The above course titles may be adjusted according to the actual course offerings.

In particular, students should take Microeconomics and Macroeconomics offered by the Department.

3. Alternative courses to Principles of Microeconomics with Recitation, Principles of Macroeconomics with Recitation, Statistics with Recitation, and Introductory Econometrics with Recitation are as announced on the Department's website.

4. The regulations will be implemented after being approved by the Department Affairs Meeting and being reported to University. The same process applies when there is any further revision in the future.
