## The Regulations for the Presidential Award Department of Economics, National Taiwan University

- 1. The regulations for the Presidential Award (hereinafter, the Award) of the Department of Economics of National Taiwan University (hereinafter, the Department) is set up in accordance with the relevant provisions of the "Regulations for the Presidential Award of National Taiwan University." The Award is only granted to the undergraduate students of the Department.
- 2. For the first-year students, the Award is granted to the top 5% students in terms of the GPA of all courses taken in the previous semester (excluding physical education).
- 3. For the second-year and third-year students, the Award is granted to the top 5% students in terms of the GPA of the required and elective courses offered by the Department and the courses listed in the specialization programs of the Department taken in the previous semester (excluding the general courses: Chinese, foreign language, liberal education courses, and physical education), and it is only granted to the students who have taken four or more of the above courses in the semester.
- 4. For the fourth-year students, the Award is granted to the top 5% students in terms of the GPA of the required and elective courses offered by the Department and the courses listed in the specialization programs of the Department taken in the previous semester (excluding the general courses: Chinese, foreign language, liberal education courses, and physical education), and it is only granted to the students who have taken two or more of the above courses in the semester.
- 5. If there is a tie under the above criteria, the student who has a higher GPA of all courses taken in the previous semester (excluding physical education) will be ranked higher. If there is still a tie, the student who takes more credits (excluding physical education) will be ranked higher.
- 6. Students who have transferred to another department or university during the review period of the Award will not be considered.
- 7. The regulations will be implemented after being passed by the Department Affairs Meeting, and the same process applies when there is any further revision in the future.
