Professor Minchung Hsu received his Ph.D. from UCLA in 2007. He is an associate professor of economics and a deputy director of the Macroeconomic Policy Program at National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies (GRIPS) in Tokyo. His research focuses on three issues: 1) designs of health insurance system, pension system and social welfare programs; 2) income and wealth inequality and optimal taxation; 3) population aging and its implications for
